- ▼ A practical approach to understanding how to grow something to eat, showing how easy and fun it can be just using simple readily available or recycled equipment
- ▼ Everything will be provided for an hour long practical workshop and we will leave you with copies of the activities, an extension sheet and diary
- ▼ The workshop will include sowing and sprouting seeds, making paper pots and how to look after the plants once germinated both inside and out
- ▼ Run by 2 members of the Hertfordshire Gardens Trust Schools Team who have extensive experience with children and growing vegetables
- ▼ Suitable for Years 3 through to 6
- ▼ Maximum 30 children per session.
- ▼ Cost £35 for each workshop payable when booking
- ▼ Available on Thursday mornings from Thursday 9th September 2010 until Thursday 21st October 2010 for an hour session either before or after morning break.
- ▼ We would expect a member of staff to be present and will need a window sill or similar space to store the planted containers. Access to water would be useful.
- ▼ Applications will be dealt with on a first come first serve basis. If all dates are full when the booking form arrives we will return the cheque.
